### “HABM: The Holocaust of All. Battle of the Memory”

The present project, whose main objective is to bring to the memory of EU citizens the Nazi extermination of PwDs, is in line with the general objective of giving citizens the cultural and historical instruments so that they may take part in constructing a united and democratic Europe in which diversity is a value which enriches, rather than a negativity to be hidden or eliminated. The construction of individual or collective identity, is based on the remembrance and historical reconstruction of the events.




